OUR MISSION

Invest to Elect (ITE) is a group of like-minded women who are passionate about electing Democratic candidates who support reproductive freedom.

ITE achieves this by hosting 8-10 fundraising events for recommended Democratic candidates and organizations.

We support Democratic candidates for federal office, including in the U.S. Senate and U.S. House, as well as candidates for statewide office, including governors, state supreme court justices, and state attorneys general.



HOW IT WORKS

- Each calendar year, ITE members commit to invest a minimum of \$3,000 in ITE-vetted candidates and organizations. (first year members may commit to \$1,500; second year \$2,000)
- We organize and host 8-10 private events for our investors each year. Events are generally in-person on weekdays, providing members with the opportunity to interact with candidates in person.
- Members' investments go directly to our candidates and organizations via specifically designated links for ITE contributions, or by check made out to the candidate/organization.
- Candidate events typically cost \$1,000 to attend. Once a member has met her \$3,000 annual commitment, events cost \$500 to attend. First and second year members may attend all events for \$500.
- Members may bring guests to events for \$250 (or guests 35 and under for \$100). (Limitations apply.)
- Events supporting organizations are typically \$500 to attend.
- Members pay dues of \$150 per year to support operating costs.
- Our organization is staffed by volunteers. We welcome members to volunteer on our committees: Membership, Investment Strategy, Events, Civic Action and Communication.

INVESTMENT **STRATEGY**

Our Investment Strategy Committee evaluates candidates and pro-democracy organizations that align with ITE's mission for recommendation to the Steering Committee which selects who we will host. Events are then scheduled. Each ITE member is then invited to select which candidates or organizations she would like to support. We evaluate:

- 1 Competitive federal races including U.S. Senate; US House and President when in cycle
- Critical statewide races including governors, supreme court justices and attorneys general
- Grassroots organizations in states where we are supporting candidates including voter engagment groups and social media voices
- National organizations strategically selected to allow investment in protecting our democracy
